BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Albert Ellis Allin, 1906-1966, was a physician, naturalist and writer who spent most of his working career in Fort Williams, Ontario, where he collected specimens of birds, eggs, and flowers which he sent to the Royal. Ontario Museum for its collections.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The papers contain his diaries with field notes, scrapbooks, correspondence, drafts of articles, notes, minutes of meetings for organizations of which he was an officer, and printed materials including newspaper clippings of columns written by other naturalists but collected by Allin. Included in the correspondence are letters from J.L. Baillie whose papers are also in the Thomas Fisher Rare Book Library, Manuscript Collection 127.
