Collection consists of the research files for Pathy's book *Waterfront Blue: Labour Strife at the Port of Montreal, 1960-1978*, published by the University of Toronto Press in 2004.

Biography

Through his family-owned shipping company, Alexander Pathy was an executive member of the Shipping Federation Council, which later became the Maritime Employers Association (MEA), of which he became the first chair in 1969. From 1981 to 1991, Pathy was a vice-president of the University of Toronto and professor of management and industrial relations, teaching at the university's Centre for Industrial Relations until his retirement in 1995. He currently resides in Barbados and is the managing director of Fednav (Barbados).
