#### **Biographical note**

Bryce Kanbara was born in 1947 in Ontario. He attended McMaster University, where he earned a Bachelor of Arts in English literature and Art History in 1971. He was a pivotal figure in the arts community in Hamilton, and a founding member and first administrator of Hamilton Artists Inc. He is currently the curator and proprietor of You Me Gallery in Hamilton. Throughout his career as a visual artist, he has held many curatorial positions, including those at Burlington Art Centre, Art Gallery of Hamilton, Glenhyrst Art Gallery of Brant, JC Gallery at the Japanese Canadian Cultural Centre. He has been the Visual Arts, Crafts & Design Officer at the Ontario Arts Council, and Co-chair of the Board of Directors, Workers Arts & Heritage Centre. In 2021, he received the Governor General's Award in Visual and Media Arts for outstanding contribution.

Kanbara has also been an active member of the Japanese Canadian community. He has been the Executive Director of the Toronto Chapter of the National Association of Japanese Canadians, Chair of the NAJC Endowment Fund and National Executive member.

#### Scope and Content

Dates range: 1944-2013

Extent: 5 boxes (1.8 linear meters)

The collection consists of material collected by Kanbara during his time as an active member of the Japanese Canadian Citizens' Association (later the National Association of Japanese Canadians) and the various off-shoot organizations. Many of the records are from the period of the Japanese Canadian Centennial, and continue from the many organizations it inspired.

Records relating to Japanese Canadian Redress are also included, including material from Sodan Kai. Later records from the NAJC's art events where Kanbara played a significant role are present, like the AI symposium.

**Note:** Titles, unless given in square brackets, have been taken from the original material / containers.

**Arrangement:** Material was packed by the donor and arranged into loose series when packed.

The series have been respected when it was clear where the record could be placed.

### Series 1: National Japanese Canadian Citizens' Association

Dates range: 1944-2013

Extent: 34 folders of textual records + 6 photographs : colour.

Primarily textual material created by the National Japanese Canadian Citizens' Association (later the National Association of Japanese Canadians) and collected by Kanbara as he participated in the organization. Meeting minutes, agendas, notes, and correspondence between Kanbara and others from the organization are included, almost all with marginalia by Kanbara. Records date from around the Japanese Canadian centennial and then later in the early 1990s.

**Arrangement:** Material gathered under the title NJCCA by the donor.

### Series 2: Hamilton Chapter, NAJC

Dates range: 1985-1997

Extent: 16 folders of textual records + 45 negatives : 35mm + 39 photographs + 3 contact sheets

Material created by the Hamilton Chapter of the NAJC regarding the Redress movement, the constitution of the Hamilton Chapter, and some events organized by the chapter.

Dates range: 1977-2013

Records from various events that took place in Toronto. Some records relate to the Japanese Canadian Cultural Center.

#### Series 4: AI Symposium

Dates range: 1994

Extent: 10 folders of textual records.

Dates range: 1967-1990

Planning material with notes for the various events organized by the Japanese Canadian Citizens' Association to celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Manzo Nagano, the first Japanese to settle in Canada. Most records were created in 1977, the year of the centennial.
