Biographical note

Son of Jens Christian and Ruth (Amneus) Bay, Christian Bay was born in Oslo, Norway on April 19, 1921. His sister is named Marie Bay. He first married to Nancy Ritcher, whom he divorced in 1948. He then married Juanita Evelyn Boozer in 1959 with whom he would have three children: Marit, Mia, and Jonah (previously Helge).

Professor Bay's first year in law at the University of Oslo was interrupted when he fled the country as the Nazis were said to be arresting law students involved in the production of a resistance newspaper. He did so by bicycling to the mountains and skiing across the Swedish border. Returning to Oslo, he would complete his legal studies, the equivalent of a LL.B., in 1943.

Following his studies, he left Norway in 1943 for political reasons and remained in Sweden in the service of the exiled government until the end of the war. His first assignment was to study at a special Norwegian wartime program for three months at Stockholm's school for police officials. After passing his exams in March 1944, he was assigned to police work. For the first three months, he worked in a semi-military camp for Norwegians at Gottröra north of Stockholm. Then, he served as a staff member of the Royal Norwegian Consulate in Gothenburg for approximately twelve months. Professor Bay's service with the Norwegian police continued for almost another year in Oslo after liberation. He was responsible was to preparing the government's case in the prosecution of Norwegian Nazis who had collaborated with the Germans.

In the fall of 1946 he was awarded the Rockefeller Fellowship. Professor Bay studied at the University of Chicago from August 1946 to February 1947 and at Harvard University from September 1947 to May 1948. The interruption in studies for the fellowship was spent serving as an attaché with the Royal Norwegian Embassy in Washington through an office in New York. Following the end of his fellowship, Bay returned to Oslo in 1948 and participated in establishing the Institute of Social Research with a group of young social scientists.

Professor Bay then completed his PhD at the University of Oslo in 1959, publishing his thesis as a book, *The Structure of Freedom*, which won the 1959 Woodrow Wilson Foundation's book award. During his doctoral studies, Bay taught at the University of Oslo in 1955, Michigan State University in 1956 as an instructor of political science, and the University of California at Berkley as an assistant professor in the Speech department from 1957 to 1962.

He was then hired by Stanford University as a lecturer and research associate for the Study of the Human Problem from 1961 to 1966. At the University of Alberta, Professor Bay was appointed the rank of professor and head of the Department of Political

Science from 1966 to 1969. He stepped down to the sole role of professor from 1969 to 1972. Professor Bay then moved to the University of Toronto from which he retired in 1988.

Professor Bay's research interests included the topics of peace studies, political philosophy and the psychology of politics. His work is regarded as an explication and defense of what he called "radical humanism". Bay considered his five principal publications to be the *Structure of Freedom* (1958, 1964,

1970), Strategies of Political Emancipation (1981), "Politics and Pseudopolitics" (1965), "Political and

Apolitical Students: Facts in Search of Theory" (1967), and "Peace and Critical Political Knowledge as Human Rights" (1980).

Professor Bay was actively involved in the profession and in the wider community. He was a fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, a member of the governing council of the American Political Science Association from 1971 to 1973, chair for the Caucus for a New Political Science from 1971 to 1972, a member of the council of the International Society of Political Psychology from 1981 to 1983. His 1969 defeat in the run for presidency of the American Political Science Association was a hotly contested debate.

Scope and content

Date range: 1941-1990

Extent: 8.90 m (72 of boxes) of textual, publications, photographs, sound recordings and moving images

This accession documents Professor Bay's personal and professional life. A little over half of the material consists of correspondence to and from Bay of a professional and personal nature. Some of the personal letters include frank opinions of situations in his professional life. Approximately half of the correspondence includes carbon copies and originals written by Bay. The principal years covered are the 1960s to the 1980s. There is also a great deal of material on the Norwegian resistance movement.

The addresses, publications and manuscripts form the second and third largest grouping of material. The latter consists of final copies, drafts, and correspondence related to tributes, letters to the editor, book reviews, as well as books, book chapters, and articles written by Bay from 1949 to 1987.

The remainder of the material consists of personal and biographical documents (his "personal collections" include 'illegal' papers of the Norwegian resistance during World War II); annotated books and offprints sent to Bay; some of his teaching material at the following universities: Michigan State, the University of California Berkley, Stanford, Alberta, and Toronto; material related to his activities in professional associations such

as the American Political Science Association and the Caucus for a New Political Science; photographs; and special media which mainly includes recordings of addresses.

This fond also includes a small sous-fonds on the personal and professional life of his wife, Juanita Bay.

Series 1: Biographical and Personal Records

Date range: 1941-1990

Extent: 0.98 m (6 boxes) of publications, textual and graphic material

Scope and content: The series consists of biographical and personal records of Professor Bay. The material reflects his personal life, and includes press clippings, articles, and a thesis about him; personal documents such as educational records; documents of identification; personal papers related to life events (baptism, marriage, home ownership, inheritance, death certificates); calendars and a condolence scrapbook.

Arrangement: The arrangement of the material begins with biographical information (press clippings, biographies, curriculum vitae, referees, work about Bay), then personal papers, followed by what he termed "his personal collection", consisting of items primarily in Norwegian relating to his family and Norway generally. The most intriguing portion of this "collection" is the folders of "illegal papers" [/002(28) – (30)] that Professor Bay buried when he hurriedly left Norway early in World War II and which he dug up sometime after he returned. There are also books about Norwegian resistance, and two books by his uncle.

Series 2: Correspondence

Date range: 1956-1985

Extent: 4.55 m (34 boxes) of publications, textual and graphic material

Scope and content: This series contains letters written to Professor Bay by members of his family and friends, as well as professional correspondence. The correspondence is largely personal in nature in early years but becomes mainly professional in later years. The material includes replies sent by Bay. Approximately a third to half of the material is written in Norwegian.

Arrangement: grouping correspondence by several months at the time and then arranging the correspondence in alphabetical order. The remaining correspondence boxes were then divided by professional or personal nature, and by language when possible, and arranged chronologically. In the correspondence with the notations "Parts I and II", Professor Bay usually included lists of his correspondents. This system broke down in the last couple of years of his life.

Extent: 0.13 cm (1 box) of publications

Scope and content: This series consists of offprints were sent to Professor Bay as a research material and were annotated. This material may reflect Professor Bay's research interests as well as his commentaries on other academic's publications. Additional material reflecting Professor Bay's commentary on the professional field may be located in the referees and appraisal material in the academia and teaching material series and also in the book reviews of the publications and manuscript series.

Series 4: Academia and Teaching Materials

Date range: 1957-1985

Extent: 0.57 m (6 boxes) of textual and graphic material

Scope and content: This series documents some of Professor Bay's academic and associated activities. It includes teaching material (reading lists, syllabi, lectures, and exams) and his work within academia (committee work, appraisals and references, and departmental involvement) at the various universities where he taught. The files on "referees and appraisals" at the University of Toronto include references for academics and students and comments on books and articles forwarded to him for his input. Also included are files on the proposal to abolish the death penalty in California and, in particular, the attempt to stop the execution of convicted murderer and rapist, Caryl Chessman; and copies of Key List Mailing: Selected Documents of Current and Lasting Interest in the Civil Rights Movement, a biweekly publication produced by the San Francisco Regional Office of the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee (SNCC).

Note: Additional material related to academia and teaching material may be located in the correspondence series. Material related to his research in addresses and

publications is located in the publications series. Material related to his involvement in professional associations can be found in the professional association series.

Arrangement: The arrangement of this series is grouped by university. The material was then sub-divided between teaching material (reading lists, syllabuses, lecture notes, exams, and notes on students) and other additional material (memos, committees, and appraisals and referees for individuals and publications). Following this sub-division, material was then arranged chronologically.

Series 5: Addresses

Date range: 1969-1987

Extent: 0.67 m (6 boxes) of textual records

Scope and content: This series reflects Bay's research interests that were expressed through addresses as presentations for academic conferences and public lectures. Related material, such as correspondence and drafts, are arranged with the corresponding address. Additional material related to addresses presented at panels and conferences can be found in the professional associations series. Additional correspondence related to addresses may be located in the correspondence series.

Arrangement: The material is arranged chronologically by year

Date range: 1949-1988

Extent: 1.75 m (11 boxes) of textual records and publications

Scope and content: This series reflects Professor Bay's research interests that were published in academic journals, as well as sources for public consumption such as magazines and newsletters. The material in this series includes tributes, letters to the editor, commentaries, and publications (books, book chapters, and articles). Related material is arranged with the corresponding manuscript which may include documents

such as correspondence, drafts, publication releases, and royalty statements.

Additional correspondence related to publications and manuscripts may be located in the correspondence series.

Arrangement: The material is grouped by genre and then arranged chronologically by year. Book reviews were consolidated by year with titles marked on the label of each folder.

Series 7: Associations

Date range: 1969-1978

Extent: 0.39 m (3 boxes) of textual records

Scope and content: This series reflects Professor Bay's involvement in the American Political Science Association and its radical Caucus for a New Political Science which was formed by 200 dissident political scientists, of which Professor Bay was one, at the September, 1967 meeting of the APSA. Bay was president from 1971 to 1972. Material included is minutes of meetings, correspondence, newsletters, memos, and election material. Some material related to addresses presented at panels and conferences can be found in this series. Related material may also be located in the correspondence series.

Arrangement: The files were organized by Professor Bay. The series was then arranged by professional organization and grouped by genre (such as notes or correspondence) or subject (such as election).
