## **Biographical Note:**

Timothy Findley (1930-2002) was a Canadian novelist and playwright. Born in Toronto, Findley started his career in the arts by pursuing dancing and acting, including participating in the Ontario Stratford Festival's first season in 1953. He studied at the London Central School of Speech and Drama and starred in the premiere of Thornton Wilder's play *The Matchmaker* in 1954. Through Wilder, Findley met actress Ruth Gordon, who in turn encouraged him to pursue writing. He eventually left acting to focus exclusively on writing. Findley published a series of ten novels and three collections of short stories over the remainder of his career, starting with *The Last of the Crazy People* in 1967. Findley also continued to write plays and scripts for theatre and television, including in collaboration with his partner William Whitehead, whom he met in 1962. International acclaim for his third novel, *The Wars* (1977), including a Governor General's Award and 1983 film adaptation, established his literary reputation. The recipient of numerous awards, he was appointed as an officer of the Order of Canada in 1985. Findley also was heavily involved in activism and professional service, including serving as a founding member and Chair of the Writer's Union of Canada and President of the Canadian Chapter of PEN International. He died in 2001 at his residence in France.

Frank J. Marchese is an academic psychologist, poet, and instructor in the Department of Psychology at York University. He obtained his PhD in psychology from the University of Toronto in 1976 and has published in the fields of developmental psychology and the history of psychology, including *Coming into Being: Sabina Spielrein, Jung, Freud, and Psychoanalysis* (2015). As a poet, he has published four books of verse: *Verse in the Key of "C"* (2005), *Light and Dark* (2013), *Pandemic Poems and Other Musings* (2021), and *Return of the Confessed* (2022).

**Scope and Content:** Papers consist of 24 letters exchanged between Timothy Findley and Frank Marchese between 1990 and 2000. The letters discuss a shared interest in Ezra Pound and Findley's travel and writing activities, among other topics. Marchese's letters to Findley include signed photocopies, corrected typed copies, and printed copies from word processing applications. Letters from Findley are signed originals printed from word processing applications or typed with an electric typewriter and are accompanied by the original enclosing envelope. Also included is one letter between William Whitehead and Marchese.

Custodial history: Papers were donated by Frank Marchese in 2022.
