Includes archival material related to Red Robin Press and the life and work of Mark and Marion Frank. Subjects covered include the book projects *The Mackenzie Panels: The Strange Case of Niagara's Fallen Arch* and *1837 Rebellion: A Tour of Toronto and Nearby Places*, as well as the online project Stones of Rebellion, and files of photographs and negatives used for this and other research on plaques and monuments. Also included are files on seniors' activism; the Toronto Branch of VANA (Veterans Against Nuclear Arms); the Women's Royal Canadian Naval Service (WRCNS) reunion in Toronto, 2003; various book proposals and correspondence related to Progress Books, including submission to the Royal Commission on Book Publishing, 1971; miscellaneous files on labour and left history, including Toronto Typographical Union and the Mackenzie-Papineau Battalion; the campaign to mark the Paul Robeson centenary (1898) and other occasions.
