BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Prof. David R. Cameron is a political scientist who has worked as both an academic and civil servant. His research focuses on federalism, national unity and English-French relations in Canada, domestic and foreign constitutional development, and intergovernmental relations.

Prof. Cameron received his BA from the University of British Columbia (1963), and M.Sc. and Ph.D. from the London School of Economics (1966, 1969). His academic career began at Trent University, where he was a member of the Political Studies Department (1968-1980). There, he worked as a Senior Tutor at Catharine Parr Traill College (1969-1970), Chairman of the Department of Political Studies (1970-1975), and Dean of Arts and Science (1975-1977).

After his time at Trent, Prof. Cameron began working for the federal government, in various capacities. In 1977, Prof. Cameron was appointed Director of Research of the Pepin-Robarts Task Force on Canadian Unity (1977-1979). He was then Advisor in the Federal-Provincial Relations Office (Government of Canada) and member of the Coordination Group working on the Quebec Referendum (1979-1980), and then Assistant Secretary to the Cabinet, Strategic and Constitutional Planning in the Federal-Provincial Relations Office (1980-1982). From 1982-1985, he worked as Assistant Undersecretary of State, in Education Support, where he oversaw the creation of the federal government's Canadian Studies support programme (1982-1985).

Prof. Cameron joined the University of Toronto in 1985 as Vice-President of Institutional Relations and Professor of Political Science. He returned to government in 1987, when he was appointed Deputy Minister of Intergovernmental Affairs for the Ontario Government. He served in that role until 1989, when he was appointed Deputy Minister and Special Advisor to the Premier on Constitutional Reform and Ontario Representative to the Government of Quebec.

In 1990, Prof. Cameron returned to the University of Toronto as Professor of Political Science and continued to advise the Ontario government in his capacity as Special Constitutional Advisor to the Premier of Ontario (1990-1995) and Advisor to the Ontario Government on intergovernmental relations (1995-2001). Prof. Cameron served as one of the Province's chief negotiators during the Charlottetown constitutional discussions. In 1995, he and Jill Wherrett completed a research study for the Royal Commission on Aboriginal Peoples which examines the relationship between Native people and the Government of Ontario.

Prof. Cameron has also provided research and advice to numerous inquiries and commissions, including the Romanow Commission on the Future of Health Care in Canada (2001-2003) and the Walkerton Inquiry (2001-2002). In his capacity as fellow of the Forum of Federations, Prof. Cameron provided technical support to the Sri Lankan Peace Process, which was seeking resolution to the dispute between the Sri Lankan government and the Tamil Tigers.

Prof. Cameron has served a number of administrative roles at the University of Toronto, including as Acting Vice-Dean of Undergraduate Education and Teaching in the Faculty of Arts and Science (2003-2004), Acting Chair of the Department of Political Science (2002-2003), Associate Chair and Director of Undergraduate Studies in the Dept. of Political Science (1997-2001) and Chair of the Department of Political Science from 2006-2012. In January 2014, he was appointed Dean of the Faculty of Arts and Science at the University of Toronto, after serving as interim Dean since May 2013.

In 2002, Prof. Cameron was became a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada and was awarded the University of Toronto Ludwick and Estelle Jus Memorial Human Rights Prize.

Fonds consists of the personal records of Prof. David R. Cameron, political scientist. The majority of the records document Prof. Cameron's work with the federal and provincial governments, rather than his academic work.

Much of the fonds documents Prof. Cameron's work with the federal and Ontario governments on constitutional renewal, national unity, and French-English relations in the late 1970s and 1980s. In particular, there is significant documentation of the Pépin-Robarts Task Force on Canadian Unity, and Cameron's work with the Federal-Provincial Relations Office. Prof. Cameron's work on post-secondary education with the Secretary of State is also well documented, as is his work on constitutional renewal and Ontario-Quebec relations with the Ontario government in the 1990s.

Records relating to this government service include day planners and steno pads, correspondence and memos, briefings, news clippings, government documents, reports, proposals, research and background files, travel records, contracts, drafts and revisions, and meeting agendas, minutes and briefings.

Fonds also includes records relating to Prof. Cameron's involvement with the Romanow Commission on the Future of Health Care in Canada (2001-2003), the Walkerton Inquiry (2001-2002), and the Sri Lankan peace process (2002-2005).

Academic records include employment records, correspondence, some conference files, and publication files, especially those related to his Patterns of Association project (1997-2006).

Accessions: B2014-0009

Access: Files in series 7 (Secretary of State), 10 (Constitutional Renewal), 12 (Romanow Commission), and 13 (Walkerton Inquiry) are restricted until 20 years after the date of last file activity.

Language: There are some French language records in series 5.

Related accessions: Prof. Richard Simeon (B2013-0025) was one of Prof. Cameron's colleagues who had similar research interests.

SERIES 1: Personal records and early career

1966-2004, predominant 1980s

0.16 m of textual records
9 photographs

Series consists of records relating to Prof. Cameron's early career and personal life. Records pertaining to various positions held by Prof. Cameron (including at Trent University, the University of Toronto, and various government departments) include offers of employment, staff appointment forms, appraisal reports, salary revisions, training records, and correspondence.

Further records relating to Prof. Cameron's employment at Trent University include course syllabi and a copy of the Trent University Student newspaper, *Arthur*, (1976) with a cover story about an English Department scandal during Prof. Cameron's time as Trent's Dean of Arts and Science. Records relating to his time on the Editorial Board of the *Journal of Canadian Studies* (1982-1985) include minutes of the editorial board meeting.

Records classed as 'personal' primarily relate to professional matters of particular import (ex: appointments and promotions), and include correspondence, peer reviews, letters of reference, employment records, other people's CVs, congratulatory notes, and membership records. One file also includes a handwritten letter from Jane Jacobs. One file consists of a diary recording Prof. Cameron's time in England in 1966.

The first file in this series includes file lists and inventories of Prof. Cameron's records during various points in his career. These may be useful to researchers working with records in other series, as some documents are listed at the item level.

Series also includes 9 photographs: primarily posed portraits and a photograph of Prof. Cameron at the Conference on the University into the 21st century in May 1984.

Arrangement note: Files in this series are arranged alphabetically.

SERIES 2: Conferences and presentations

1979-1983, 1997-2001

0.16 m of textual records

Series consists of a few files relating to various workshops and presentations in which Prof. Cameron participated, including presentations for the Canadian Centre for Management Development on public service, citizenship and intergovernmental relations.

SERIES 3: Planners

Series consists of Prof. Cameron's day planners, which include notes regarding appointments, meetings, personal events, and some notes to self. Some earlier planners seem to be used as diaries, recording events after they happened.

SERIES 4: Steno notebooks

1982-2012

Series consists of steno notebooks kept by Prof. Cameron for much of his career, in which he recorded his own notes from meetings, events, speeches and other activities, as well as notes for projects and other ongoing work.

Arrangement note: Notebooks are arranged in chronological order.

SERIES 5: Task Force on Canadian Unity

1977-1979

2.26 m of textual records

In 1977, Prof. Cameron was appointed Director of Research of the Pépin-Robarts Task Force on Canadian Unity (also known as the Pépin-Robarts Commission). The Task Force was created by Pierre Trudeau after the Parti Québécois was elected in 1976 and held public meetings to collect the opinions of Canadians and then advise the government on issues of national unity.

Records in this series include reports, drafts, meeting notes, correspondence, minutes and supporting documentation.

Meeting files were kept in binders, and in addition to agendas and summaries of discussions and observations, also include supporting documentation such as budget proposals, progress reports, proposals, agenda, memos, and research material. Background files were kept on particular individuals (academics, politicians and other figures) whose work was consulted as experts in the field. These files include correspondence and memos, meeting notes, news clippings, articles and other supporting research, as well as feedback on drafts and other work done by the Task Force. Some files include extensive discussion of the direction of the Task Force and the content of its findings.

Working files include summaries of trips to various communities, notes, news clippings, lists of participants at hearings, lists of researchers, speeches, records from the Steering and Editorial Committee, and discussions about the Task Force's relationship with the Institute of Intergovernmental Relations at Queen's University (then directed by Richard Simeon).

Arrangement note: Files are organized into 5 categories: reports, chapter drafts, meetings, people files (background papers), and working files. Within each category, files are arranged alphabetically.

Language: Some records are in French, in particular in background papers filed under francophone individuals.

SERIES 6: Federal-Provincial Relations Office

1971-1982, predominant 1976-1982

0.85 m of textual records

Series consists of records relating to Prof. Cameron's work in the Federal-Provincial Relations Office (FPRO), within the Privy Council Office (PCO).

From 1979-1980, Prof. Cameron served as Advisor in the Federal-Provincial Relations Office, and a member of the Coordination (Tellier) Group and successor groups, working on the Quebec referendum. Then, from 1980-1982, Prof. Cameron served as the Assistant Secretary to the Cabinet, Strategic and Constitutional Planning, in the Federal-Provincial Relations Office. According to his CV, this position had him “responsible for strategic planning with respect to constitutional change, both before and after patriation, and for broad federal policy and planning with respect to federal-provincial relations in general.”

The majority of the series consists of chronological files (‘PCO diaries’) kept by Prof. Cameron to track business in and out of the office. These include briefings, news clippings, various statements, press releases, reports, proposals, meeting notes, correspondence, reports of work done, and memos for the Prime Minister and various ministers, including Jean Chrétien (then Minister of Justice). Records relate to various issues, but most pertain to Quebec sovereignty

3 files relate to the “Constitutional Sourcebook: A guide to the constitutional views of selected governmental and non-governmental organizations,” which was prepared by the Planning, Analysis, and Research division of the Federal-Provincial Relations Office in 1980. Other files relate to Federal-Provincial conferences on the constitution and economy, 1979-1982, including reports, briefings, proposals, and other records.

SERIES 7: Secretary of State

1978-1998, predominant 1981-1985

1.31 m of textual records

Prof. Cameron spent 3 years as Assistant Undersecretary of State, Education Support (1982-1985). He was Senior Official Responsible for the Education Support Programs Branch and according to his CV, was “responsible for the federal EPF [Established Programs Financing] transfer payments to the provinces in support of post-secondary education, the Canada Student Loans Program, the Official Languages in Education Program, the National Program in Support of Canadian Studies, and the Secretary of State’s involvement in international education affairs.” Prof. Cameron also oversaw the creation of the federal government’s Canadian Studies support programme.

Records in this series include those relating to post-secondary education (PSE), including briefing books for various meetings, chronological files, research materials, working files, conference files, correspondence, memos, briefs, reports, discussion papers, speeches, news clippings and other records. Records relate to a variety of issues, such as the student loans program, official languages, SSHRC (The Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council), vouchers, and the Bovey Commission (on the Future Development of the Universities of Ontario).

Later records relate to the federal government’s Canadian Studies Support Programme and include work contracts, invoices, progress reports, and proposals. Series also consists of some records

relating to other matters handled by the Secretary of State, such as international and intergovernmental relations.

A detailed item list of the contents of many of these files can be found files in Prof. Cameron's original file index found in Box /001(01)

Arrangement note: Records are divided into the following categories: briefing books, PSE chronological files, working files, Canadian studies, and other records.

SERIES 8: Resource material: government documents on the constitution and free trade

1979-1991

Series consists of various resource material used by Prof. Cameron on the constitution and free trade. Most are government documents and reports.

SERIES 9: Press clippings

Sept-Nov 1992

Series consists of daily press clippings (photocopies of newspaper articles) compiled by the Communications Branch on various issues of import to the government, but especially relating to the constitution.

Arrangement note: Clippings are arranged chronologically

SERIES 10: Constitutional renewal

1990-2004

2.14 m of textual records

Series consists of records relating to Prof. Cameron's work on constitutional renewal, particularly at the provincial level, after his return to academia. This especially pertains to his advisory work for the Ontario Government and its Premier. Records in this series relate to various groups and meetings, and attempts were made to keep records from each group (or set of meetings) together. In some cases, groups were interfiled together, in which case such segregation was not possible.

1. The series begins with the records of the **Constitutional Working Group (CWG)**, whose purpose was to "advise the Attorney General and support the Deputy Ministers' Committee in the work which it is undertaking in the post-Meech environment." Its assigned projects were to assess Quebec's constitutional proposals, conduct a survey of bilateral federalism, identify potential areas of constitutional pressure/reform, review recent international experience with confederation, support the Ontario Select Committee on Public Consultation, and organize a meeting with Expert Advisors (from terms of reference, /048(06)). Records of the CWG include terms of reference, research material, conference material, memos and correspondence, discussion papers, addresses and other records. Records also reflect discussions with Native groups about their relationship to the constitution and the Government of Canada.
2. Prof. Cameron also chaired the **Constitutional Advisory Group (CAG)** in his capacity at the Ministry of Intergovernmental Affairs. One of its goals was to promote the Ontario Government's proposal for the inclusion of a social charter in the Constitution. Records from this group include correspondence and memos, proposals, agendas and minutes, and notes. These records were typically filed chronologically; this arrangement has been maintained.
3. The series also contains significant documentation from the **Continuing Committee on the Constitution (CCC)**, including reports, proposals, drafts, discussion papers, briefing notes, background documents, proposed clauses, responses from provincial governments, and agendas. Records include the opinions and reactions of many of the provinces with regards to proposed constitutional and senate reform. Records from the Multilateral Meetings on the Constitution (see next section) may also be filed in some of these folders.
4. Records relating to the **Multilateral Meetings on the Constitution** include lists of delegates, meeting transcripts, legal decisions, meeting reports, records of meetings, status reports, drafts, and memos. Many of these records are mixed in with records for the Continuing Committee on the Constitution (see above).
5. Records under the heading **Ontario Government Records on Constitutional Renewal** relate to a variety of meetings and groups (including those listed above) that were kept by Prof. Cameron, typically in chronological order (ex. one file per month) or by project phases. These files include minutes, draft reports, briefing books, correspondence, and other records.

6. **Later advisory work:** Records relating to post 1992 work that Prof. Cameron did with the Ontario Government, providing advice on constitutional matters throughout the 1990s, and then with the Panel on the Future of Government in Ontario (2002-2004). Prof. Cameron (with Graham White and Celine Mulhern) produced *Democracy in Ontario*, a report for the Panel on the Future Role of Government in Ontario, in August 2003.

Arrangement note: Records are divided into categories numbered above. There are detailed lists of documents for some of these files in Prof. Cameron's original box/file lists B2014-0009/001(01).

Access: Restricted. Files are closed until 20 years after the last date of file activity.

SERIES 11: Research and publications

1983-2006

0.35 m of textual records

Series consists of records relating to various research projects and publications Prof. Cameron worked on, relating to federalism, national unity, and multigovernance.

Records also document Prof. Cameron's work on the Patterns of Association project. Prof. Cameron served as a Principal Investigator (along with Richard Simeon and Jane Jenson) on the project, which was originally proposed as "Patterns of Association in Canadian Civil Society: Linguistic Relations in Non-governmental Organizations" and later called "Language Practices in Civil Society: Patterns of Association in Canadian Voluntary Organizations." The project conducted case studies at various NGOs, including associations in the business, agricultural, municipal and health sectors, the Canadian Council for Social Development, The World University Service of Canada, Amnesty International, and EGALE (Equality for Gays and Lesbians Everywhere). This research led to workshops and a book: *Language Matters: How Canadian Voluntary Associations Manage French and English*, by David Cameron and Richard Simeon (Vancouver: UBC Press, 2009), 214 pp.

"Patterns of Association" records include project proposals, contracts, conference records, correspondence, meeting notes and agendas, financial records, chapter drafts, and notes.

SERIES 12: Romanow Commission

1995-2003

0.19 m of textual records

In 2001, the Romanow Commission on the Future of Health Care in Canada posted Requests for Proposals, looking for research teams to address particular issues. Prof. Cameron became the member of one such teams, which looked at fiscal federalism and health, and was led by Harvey Lazar, Director of the Institute of Intergovernmental Relations at Queen's University.

Prof. Cameron's records relating to the Romanow Commission include background material from the Commission, including the 2003 First Ministers' Accord on Health Care Renewal, material produced by the C.D. Howe Institute and Fraser Institute, news clippings, government documents, and papers, reports, and other material submitted to the Commission by various individuals and organizations. Series also includes "health reports binders" that consist of reports on issues in Canadian health care by various bodies, including The Standing Senate Committee on Social Affairs, Science and Technology, the Quebec Clair Commission, the Saskatchewan Commission on Medicare, the National Forum of Health and the Alberta Premier's Advisory Council on Health.

Series also includes an article on "Cooperation and Dispute Resolution in the Canadian Health Care Field" by David Cameron and Jennifer McCrea-Logie (2002), and material from a workshop on The Canadian Health Act and Canadian Federalism at Queen's University (4 Apr 2003), led by Prof. Cameron.

SERIES 13: Walkerton Inquiry

1994-2001, predominant 2001

0.53 m of textual records

The Walkerton Inquiry investigated the contamination of the water supply of Walkerton, Ontario with E. coli bacteria in 2000. It also addressed, in general, the safety of drinking water in Ontario. Prof. Cameron wrote *Drinking Water Safety: Does Ownership and Management Matter? A Commissioned Research Report for the Walkerton Inquiry*, 2001, 200 pp. He also assisted Justice Dennis O'Connor in the preparation of a portion of the Walkerton Report, Part II, 2002.

Records in this series consist primarily of official submissions to the inquiry and research files, arranged alphabetically, on the topic of water purification, public works and public policy. Series also includes reports, notes and drafts.

SERIES 14: Sri Lanka

2000-2004

Prof. Cameron joined the Board of the Forum of Federations in 2002. His work with the Forum led him to provide technical support to the Sri Lankan Peace Process, which was seeking resolution to the dispute between the Sri Lankan government and the Tamil Tigers. Prof. Cameron participated in peace process meetings in Sri Lanka (26-30 April 2002, 30 August-5 September 2002) Sri Lanka/Oslo (25 November-5 December), London (22-23 December), Thailand (3-10 January 2003), Berlin (5-9 February 2003), and Sri Lanka/Tokyo (10-20 March 2003; 24 August-3 September 2004; 26 March-7 April 2005). He also wrote papers and delivered presentations on peace and governance in Sri Lanka.

Records in this series include correspondence, reports, research, proposals from the Tamil Tigers and Sri Lankan government, and articles and presentations on the peace process. Records from particular peace talks include press releases, debriefing comments, texts of speeches, correspondence, maps and other travel documents, news clippings, and notes.

Series also consists of 2 photographs of Prof. Cameron, taken on his travels.

Arrangement note: Files seem to have been pulled together quickly in order to take material to particular events or meetings. As such, each file may contain material from a range of dates and events.
