Etienne Gilson was a professor of philosophy at universities in France and an internationally renowned scholar by the time he lectured at St. Michael's College in 1927. He was the founder (1929), along with the Basilian Fathers, of the Pontifical Institute of Mediaeval Studies for graduate work in philosophy. He held the position of Director from 1929 to 1978. The Gilson fonds includes his correspondence (personal and professional) on philosophical matters, and social problems in the light of his expertise in Thomistic philosophy. His articles and lectures on social and political subjects are recorded from his time at St. Michael's and PIMS.

This fonds contains Etienne Gilson's correspondence, articles, lectures and pocket diaries for the period 1917-1978. It also contains the notebooks of Abbe Andre Gilson, younger brother of Etienne.

Etienne Gilson first lectured at the Pontifical Institute of Mediaeval Studies (PIMS) in 1927. He was the founding Director of PIMS and held the position from 1929 until he died in 1978. His papers include his correspondence with family and scholars, on personal and philosophical matters. Many are in original form but some are photocopies from other archives. His articles and lectures are recorded from his time at PIMS, as Lecturer (1927-1978) and Director (1929-1978). *579 cm.*
