Biographical sketch:

James Allan "Jim" Coutts (16 May 1938-31 December 2013) was born in High River, Alberta and raised in Nanton, Alberta, where he began his career in politics early, rising to prominence as President of the Young Liberals in the early 1960s. Coutts received his law degree from the University of Alberta in 1961, and received an MBA from Harvard Business School in 1968. In his career as a Liberal Party of Canada political staffer, Coutts was a Secretary to Prime Minister Lester B. Pearson (1963-1966), and later became Principal Secretary to Prime Minister Pierre Elliott Trudeau (1975-1981). Coutts twice ran for federal office in the Toronto Trinity-Spadina riding in 1981 and 1984, but was defeated both times by New Democratic Party candidate Dan Heap. In his professional life he worked as a consultant with McKinsey & Co. from 1968-1970 and was a partner with the Canada Consulting Group from 1970-1975. Following his unsuccessful bid for office, Coutts was a principal with Lowther Consultants Ltd. and C.E.O. of Canadian Investment Capital Ltd. He remained actively involved with the Liberal Party of Canada, primarily as an advisor, and was also known for his philanthropy work, serving on the boards of Pearson College, the Foundation of the Hospital for Sick Children and the Royal Ontario Museum as well as being a co-founder of the W.O. Mitchell Literature Prize. He was an active birder and hunter and member of Nature Conservancy of Canada. In 2001 he was made a member of the Order of Canada. An active collector of Canadian art, he made other significant donations to the University of Lethbridge, including the donation of his Nanton homestead.

Scope and content:

The James Allan Coutts fonds consists of rebound diaries in custom enclosures, additional notebooks and diaries and extensive textual records and graphic material supplementing Coutts' diary keeping activities. Also retained were Coutts' essays and research for a retrospective political memoir and on various social policy topics that concerned Coutts following his retirement. The diaries are

particularly detailed for the period of Coutts' involvement in the administration of Prime Minister Pierre Elliott Trudeau office, as a chronicle of behind the scenes political strategizing and policy making. Also the fonds becomes again more detailed from the 1990s until Coutts' death in 2013, when the diaries become decidedly more personal, reflecting Coutts' interests in nature, travel and the arts, as well as the social and political landscape of Canada. Material concerning Coutts family genealogical research and other private records have been deaccessioned and transferred to the University of Lethbridge. An appendix of alphabetically arranged correspondents has been added to the finding aid for the benefit of researchers. Individual correspondents are also listed at the file level.

Scope and content:

The bound diaries series contains custom diaries and a select number of pocket diaries that were rebound and for which Coutts had custom enclosures built. Most of the volumes were edited for

content during Coutts' lifetime and constitute a retrospective of his time in office with two prominent Liberal Prime Ministers. The diaries after 1991 include numerous photographs and inserted textual records, including personal correspondence, newspaper clippings and other keepsakes as well as handwritten and typed diary entries.

Scope and content:

The Series includes source material for Coutts' diary-keeping activities, much of which was organized chronologically and sorted for Coutts by his personal assistants. Often the records have been annotated, indicating subject categories which have been preserved in the arrangement of the series. The series includes extensive correspondence, photographs, reference articles and memorabilia concerning Coutts' political and personal affairs. Wherever known or identifiable, correspondents have been listed at the file level. A large number of Coutts' more routine correspondence, concerning travel affairs and agendas was conducted by Coutts' personal assistant, Anne Drakes, and thus she and Coutts can often be presumed to be among the correspondents even when they have not been listed or identified specifically.
