Biographical note

Joseph F. Fletcher (1949-) is a political scientist and Professor Emeritus of Political Science at the University of Toronto (UofT). His major areas of focus are perceptions of civil liberties in both Canada and Australia, Canadian constitutional politics, and quantitative research design.

Prof. Fletcher was born in Philadelphia in 1949. He received his B.A. (1971) from Wright State University in Dayton, Ohio, followed by an M.A. from the University of Alberta (1973). He submitted his Ph.D thesis, *Community through participation: a look at the idea and the evidence*, in 1983 to the University of Toronto under the supervision of Christian Bay.

Prof. Fletcher's academic career was conducted primarily at the University of Toronto's Department of Political Science and Centre for Criminology. Additionally he held fellowships at the University of Essex (1982), Maison des sciences d l'homme, Paris (1983-4), York University's Institute for Social Research (1985-1990), and the Research School of the Social Sciences at the Australian National University (1991). He began as lecturer at the UofT's Department of Political Science in 1976 and was promoted to Associate Professor in 1991. Prof. Fletcher was the first in his department to introduce quantitative methods into his undergraduate courses, frequently incorporating hands-on survey and experimental exercises. This analytic method was subsequently made a degree requirement. Prof. Fletcher retired from the UofT in 2015.

Prof. Fletcher's early research focused on attitudes toward civil liberties. Following his dissertation, he and colleagues, Paul Sniderman, Peter Russell, and Philip Tetlock, began their investigation of how the recent adoption of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms (1982) was reflected in Canadian attitudes towards democratic freedoms. Commonly referred to as *The Charter Project*, the study was intended to create a baseline measurement of Canadian beliefs surrounding language rights, equality, indigenous rights, freedom of expression, freedom of religion, and criminal rights of both the general public and 'decision-makers'. It also was the first national study to use computer-assisted telephone interviewing techniques (CATI), combining randomized experiments with survey research.

Following this study, Prof. Fletcher continued his research into civil liberties in Australia where he worked with a team of researchers on the Australian Rights Project. The study surveyed individuals following the country's rejection of a ratified bill of rights. This research was accompanied by a comparative study between Canada and Australia. His later work continued to look at Canada's constitutional politics, including bi-nationalism, the judiciary, and attitudes towards specific democratic values.

Together with UofT (Psychology) colleague John Bassili, Prof. Fletcher founded the consulting firm *Arkelon Research* (1990) which provided independent research and surveying services to organizations including federal, provincial, and municipal governments. Bassili and Fletcher developed a method and apparatus for measuring response times in telephone surveys which resulted in a U.S. patent (1993). His professional activities included organization of a symposium to honour Peter Russell and the editing of an associated publication *Ideas in Actions: Essays on Politics and Law in Honour of Peter Russell* (1999). Fletcher also co-authored *The Clash of Rights: Liberty, Equality and Legitimacy in Pluralist Democracy* (1996) and, in addition to frequent conference presentations, published numerous scholarly articles. In the latter part of his career these focused on the application of statistical modelling techniques to political, psychological, biological, and educational processes.

Prof. Fletcher currently divides his time between Pacific Grove, California and Victoria, B.C. where he is appointed respectively, visiting professor at University of California Santa Cruz and lecturer at the University of Victoria.

Fonds consists of textual records documenting the professional life and work of Prof. Joseph F. Fletcher. Records include Fletcher's research, advisory work, publishing activity, teaching, conference attendance and planning, as well as documentation of his early career at the UofT. The fonds contains significant coverage of two of Prof. Fletcher's research projects, The Charter Project and the Australian Rights Project. Material is largely focused on the various issues surrounding civil and political rights in Canada which comprise a significant component of Fletcher's writing, presentations, and research. Fonds also includes extensive teaching material from Prof. Fletcher's career at the UofT, in addition to records related to his involvement in the *Ideas in Actions: Essays on Politics and Law in Honour of Peter Russell* symposium and resulting publication. Records include correspondence, typescripts and drafts, surveys, data print-outs, notes, correspondence, lecture notes, and background and reading material. Scope and content: Series consists of textual records documenting Prof. Fletcher's career and selected aspects of his personal life. Scope and content: Series consists of records reflecting Prof. Fletcher's professional activities and participation in conference planning for specific professional associations. The material documents administrative activities and the proceedings of the *Ideas in Action: Essays in Politics and Law in Honor of Peter Russell* symposium held at Innis College Town Hall, University of Toronto in 1996. Additionally, the series contains records associated with its resulting publication (1999) which was edited by Prof. Fletcher. The series also documents initiatives organized in memory of fellow political scientist, Christian Bay, comprising a published In Memorium (American Political Science Association) and a conference session (Canadian Political Science Association). One file pertains to the organization of a 1984 meeting of the International Society of Political Psychology. Records include correspondence, draft typescripts, notes, and audio recordings of the 1996 conference.

Scope and content: Series consist of records related to Prof. Fletcher's writing and publishing activity from early in his career to late 2014. Writing comprises predominantly academic articles, with the inclusion also of reviews, writing proposals, and records related to Prof. Fletcher's book, *The Clash of Rights: Liberty, Equality, and Legitimacy in Pluralist Democracy*. Additional material includes files related to the editing of the Department of Political Science's newsletter, *Discourse*. Material include typescripts, drafts, off-prints, and correspondence in addition to related background material (tables, data, and notes).

Note: Prof. Fletcher's writing and editing work is also included in various other series: Reports written as part of his consultancy are included in Series 2. The material related to the book *Ideas in Action: Essays in Politics and Law in Honor of Peter Russell* is included in Series 4 which holds documents on the associated conference of the same title.

Series 6: Teaching

Extent: 1.3m (10 boxes) of textual records

Scope and content: Series consists of records documenting Prof. Fletcher's teaching activities within the Department of Political Science at the UofT. Material included spans Prof. Fletcher's first courses as a lecturer to his final year prior to retiring from the UofT. Classes include Quantitative Methods and Research Design, Political Participation, Political Psychology (both on campus and in Siena, Italy), Public opinion and Voting, Mass Political Participation, and Topics in Canadian Politics: The Politics of Hate Speech and Pornography Laws. Material includes syllabi, lecture notes, course readings, course evaluations, in-class surveys, correspondence, and press clippings related to topical news items.

Series also includes documentation of Prof. Fletcher's 1993 Political Psychology class in which the white supremacist group, Heritage Front, and other groups were invited to

speak. While the aim of the class was intended to expose racism and intolerance, the event triggered strong reactions across campus and the city, culminating in a review by the Toronto Mayor's Committee on Community and Race Relations. Related material includes press clippings, course material, and substantial correspondence.

Series 7: Research

Date range: 1969-2011

Extent: 3.06m (24 boxes) of textual records

Scope and content: Series consists of records documenting Prof. Fletcher's research activity. It includes substantial coverage of his work within two major projects, The Charter Project and the Australian Rights Project. Series also includes additional smaller-scale studies as well as miscellaneous research files. Records relate to both the administration of these projects as well as their findings. See listing of component sections below.

Canadian attitudes towards the Charter of Rights and Freedoms: This section contains records related to research on Canadian attitudes towards civil liberties and is comprised primarily of material from the Charter Project (1986-1990) which was conducted with fellow investigators Paul Sniderman, Peter Russell, and Philip Tetlock. This research project investigated how the recent adoption of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms was reflected in Canadian attitudes towards civil liberties among various population groups. This section includes additional records from projects that followed the Charter Project and reflect Prof. Fletcher's continued research within the area. Material includes data print-outs, draft and final surveys, indices, correspondence, notes, progress documentation, and background material.

Australian Rights Project and comparative study: The Australian Rights Project (1988-1993), led by Brian Galligan, Ian McAllister, and Joseph Fletcher, investigated the level of Australian support for civil rights and freedoms. The study evaluated the beliefs of both the general public and a population of elites, mostly those in the legal community. The project was also designed to compare its results with those in other countries, in particular Canada. Material in this section includes data-print outs, notes, correspondence, indices, granting applications and records, recruitment material, research summaries, and background research.

Task Force on Foreign Students survey (University of Toronto): Records in this section relate to a study beginning in 1984 of international students at the University of Toronto organized by the Task Force on Foreign Students. The mail survey evaluated the overall experiences of foreign students at the University looking in particular at academic, financial, and personal issues faced. Material includes data, notes, reports, and background material.

Survey of Recent and Current Doctoral Students at the University of Toronto: Records in this section relate to a survey conducted regarding the attitudes, issues, and practices surrounding doctoral dissertations at the University between 1989 and 1991. The study was organized by the Committee on the Role and Nature of the Doctoral Dissertation on behalf of the Dean of Graduate Studies. Material in this section includes data, reports, notes, surveys, and correspondence.

Miscellaneous research: Records in this section cover multiple projects and ancillary areas of research, including several survey-based projects: a recurring national election study; a 1993 referendum survey, and a survey of legal scholars and professionals. Additionally, the section includes research files on topics including party identification, Canada's mission in Afghanistan, and same-sex marriage. Records comprise data print-outs, analysis, correspondence, reports, notes, and background material. Additionally, section contains copied and original material created by Prof. Fletcher's former supervisor and colleague, Christian Bay.

Arrangement: Files are arranged into sections based on significant areas of study, followed by a section covering smaller projects and miscellaneous material. Files within each section are arranged chronologically.
