THE LITERARY CLUB, 1930-1934

The papers of the Literary Club were presented to the Library by Lois Milani and Norma Lynes, July, 1984.

EXTENT: 1 box (3")

SCOPE: The papers consist of the minutes of the Club from October 29, 1930 till October 28, 1934; correspondence of various members with Mrs. Norma Lynes, 1984, including brief biographies of the members; a portion of the untitled reminiscences of Henry H. Noyes.

BACKGROUND:

The Literary Club, a successor to the earlier Ernescliffe Club, was founded by a group of graduates of Humberstone Collegiate, Toronto. They met to discuss literature and to read their own writings between 1930 and 34, while most of them were attending Victoria College, University of Toronto. Members included Dr. William Feasby, Professor Munro Beattie.
