#### **Administrative History**

Cottaging in the Go Home Bay area began in 1898 when The Madawaska Club was formed by a group associated with the University of Toronto who were interested in combining scientific research with recreation. The name was chosen because they originally hoped to acquire land along the Madawaska River south of Algonquin Park. Early activities focused around a clubhouse and research station, but over the next few decades members spread out and established private cottages, many of which still exist. For almost 100 years cottaging in the Go Home Bay area was restricted to people associated with the University of Toronto under the terms of the original Charter, but that restriction is gone and now all cottagers from The Hangdog to Indian Harbour are welcome to join The Madawaska Club at Go Home Bay. Many of the area cottagers are also shareholders in The Madawaska Club Limited which owns over 1600 acres of undeveloped land in the Go Home Bay area.

#### Scope and content

This fonds consists of records documenting the founding, early activities, and 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Madawaska Club of Go Home Bay, Ontario. The records were acquired by the University of Toronto Archives over six accessions between 1974 and 1983.

**B1974-0015:** Consists of annual meetings and reports, charter and bylaws, shares and finances, land and titles records, transportation and maintenance, committee records; historical notes and club history, 1948. Photoprints and negatives of club activities at Go Home Bay; negatives showing maps of Go Home Bay and surrounding areas contained in albums. Photo albums were compiled and maintained by Professors C.A. Chant, G.R. Anderson and Grant Robertson.

**B1975-0016:** Consists of minutes books (1901 – 1953), register of shareholders, legal files re Madawaska Club vs Galbraith (1946 – 1948) and Joyce Rankin vs Madawaska Club (1964 – 1968), memorabilia, diaries, 75th anniversary celebrations, photographs.

**B1974-0015** primarily consists of photo albums that were compiled and maintained by Professors C.A. Chant; G.R. Anderson; and Grant Robertson, a Professor of Classics at Victoria College who married Elizabeth Chant.

**B1976-0022** consists of eight albums that belonged to the Anderson Family.

**Note:** In **B1974-0015**, there are notecards tucked into the Chant: 1 file which add information to the photographs in the Chant album. Some of these notecards have been used to create the descriptions for the Chant albums, but researchers may wish to consult them in addition. Much of the descriptive information about Robertson Album B was provided by C. Trusler and I. Tomlinson.

**Note:** For **B1976-0022**, contact prints were made of negatives before they deteriorated. Duplicate negatives have been made of a number but not all prints. Image number refers to the red number on the back, also visible on many of the negatives. Images that have not been duplicated are indicated by (ND) after image number. The descriptions were provided by the photographer unless enclosed in [square] brackets. The albums all belonged to the Anderson family.

**Arrangement:** The photographs from each accession have been arranged independently. **B1974-0015/001P – /003P** consists of albums that have been disassembled. They are indicated as A, B, or C in the file description to identify the original albums. The page order has been kept. **B1976-0022/001P** consists of eight photo albums that have been disassembled.
