1889 - 1893

Biographical sketch:

Robert Elgie Macdonald, a native of Stratford, Ontario, entered Trinity Medical College in 1889. After graduating with an M.D., C.M. in 1893 he received his license and began to practice in Stratford. He died of tuberculosis in 1897 at the age of 28.

Scope and content:

Fonds consists of two notebooks of lectures from classes given by Dr. W. B. Geikie and Dr. Algernon Temple at Trinity Medical College. Also includes Dr. Macdonald's prescription notebook.

Fonds was donated in 1993 by Dr. Robert H. Welch of Toronto who received the material from Dr. Macdonald's niece in the 1960's.
