Administrative history

The Trinity College Encounter Club was established in 1962 and was active until at least January 1967, the date of the last entry in the financial records. The aims of the club do not appear to be recorded in any of the surviving materials but would seem to represent an effort to open discussion on national and international issues by bringing in speakers and holding conferences. The club established a journal, *The Encounter*, in December 1964 - at least three issues were published.

Scope and content

The records of the Trinity College Encounter Club include minutes, lists of members and activities, financial records, records of the Conference on African Affairs and the Conference on the Canadian Indian, and issues of *The Encounter*.

Notes

Immediate source of acquisition: There is no record of how these materials were acquired by the Archives. Until 1998 the records were identified as MS 269.

Arrangement: Files have been organized by the archivist.

Restrictions on access: None.
