Biographical history

Aldeburgh Connection

Dates: 1982-2013

The Aldeburgh Connection was founded in 1982 by pianists Stephen Ralls and Bruce Ubukata. Former faculty members, pianists, and coaches at the Britten-Pears School in Aldeburgh, England, Ralls and Ubukata moved to Toronto in 1978 for positions at the Faculty of Music, University of Toronto.

Starting in 1982, Ralls and Ubukata developed a Sunday afternoon vocal and piano concert series in Walter Hall that featured leading Canadian singers. The Aldeburgh Connection was officially formed as an organization and registered charity in 1986 under the name "The Aldeburgh Connection Concert Society." Their founding patron was Sir Peter Pears, and Ralls and Ubukata were co-artistic directors.

Each concert in the Sunday afternoon series was based on a theme (musical, literary, or a historical character or period) and integrated music and narration, based on letters, diaries, newspapers, and poetry. In addition to this concert series, which ran from 1982 until 2013, the Aldeburgh Connection also produced a recital series (1993-2013), featuring complete song cycles without a narrative framework, and the Young Artists Recitals series (1998-2011), renamed the Discovery Series in 2006. The Discovery Series consisted of two recitals per season and featured vocal and opera students from the University of Toronto. Following the success of three annual concerts in Bayfield, Ontario (2004-2006), the Aldeburgh Connection also established the Bayfield Festival of Song (2007-2012), which included masterclasses and concerts. Starting in 2009, they added a tour of Huron and Perth elementary schools to the festival. Ralls and Ubukata also performed with the Aldeburgh Connection at various venues in North America and the United Kingdom, including two appearances at the Aldeburgh Festival in Suffolk, England in 1988 and 1992.

The Aldeburgh Connection regularly commissioned new works by Canadian composers, including John Beckwith, Roger Bergs, John Greer, Derek Holman, Gary Kulesha, James Rolfe, Erik Ross, Harry Somers, and Timothy Sullivan. They also released seven CDs, including the 2008 Juno-nominated *Schubert among Friends*, with Gillian Keith (soprano), Colin Ainsworth and Michael Schade (tenors), and Gerald Finley (baritone). In 2013, Ralls and Ubukata were both named members of the Order of Canada.

Aldeburgh Connection fonds

Date range: 1979-2018

Extent: 5 m of textual records and other material (40 boxes)

Fonds consists of the administrative, financial, and performance records of the Aldeburgh Connection. Most of the fonds consists of materials created for, and as a result of, each concert produced by the Aldeburgh Connection, including promotional materials, scripts, annotated scores, correspondence, research notes, and reviews. The fonds also contains textual materials from the production of the Aldeburgh Connection's recording projects, general promotional events, board minutes, complete financial records, and correspondence regarding their fundraising efforts.

Arrangement: Arranged and described as received from the Aldeburgh Connection. Fonds consists of four series: Governance and finance records; Promotional events and free concerts; Recording projects; and Concerts.

Access: Unrestricted access, including display rights and consultation rights. Archival records may be viewed in the Olnick Rare Book Room at the University of Toronto Music Library.

Series A: Governance and finance records

Date range: 1982-2018

Extent: 15 cm of textual records

Series consists of the administrative and financial records of the Aldeburgh Connection, including newsletters; correspondence regarding private donations, corporate funding, and government grants; financial ledgers and budgets; and, board minutes. As a registered charity, the Aldeburgh Connection was dependent upon donations, funding, and grants, in addition to revenue from ticket sales, to support each concert season. Donations after the end of the Aldeburgh Connection concerts in 2013 were given in support of the organization's archival project, which included the creation of an online archive of sound recordings, digitized programs, and a database of their performance repertoire. The series also includes the letters of incorporation for "The Aldeburgh Connection Concert Society" and early promotional material used to obtain funding.

Series B: Promotional events and free concerts

Extent: 10 cm of textual records

Series consists of records pertaining to various promotional events and free concerts produced by the Aldeburgh Connection. The series includes materials for one concert, "Opera in the Drawing Room" (January 14, 1979) by Stephen Ralls and Bruce Ubukata, prior to the official

formation of the Aldeburgh Connection. Each file consists of programs, scripts, annotated scores (by Ralls and Ubukata), set and lighting designs, posters, and reviews.

Arrangement: Arrangement by the Aldeburgh Connection. File titles were transcribed directly from folders, as labelled by the Aldeburgh Connection, which correspond to the title of the event or concert.

Series C: Recording projects

Date range: 1992-2014

Extent: 10 cm of textual records

Series consists of correspondence, rehearsal schedules, recording take lists, budgets, and research notes regarding the production of the Aldeburgh Connection's recording projects, including one cassette and six CDs. The albums include recordings from various Aldeburgh Connection concerts, recordings with musicians featured in these concerts, and recordings of compositions commissioned by the Aldeburgh Connection.

Arrangement: Arrangement by the Aldeburgh Connection. Files are listed in ascending chronological order. File titles were transcribed directly from folders, as labelled by the Aldeburgh Connection, which correspond to the titles of their recordings.

Series D: ConcertsDate range: 1932-2014

Extent: 4.65 m of textual records

Series consists of materials produced by the Aldeburgh Connection for each of their concerts, including the Sunday Afternoon Concert Series, held at Walter Hall, Faculty of Music, University of Toronto (1982-2013); the Recital Series at the Glenn Gould Studio, Toronto (1993-2013); the Discovery Series (also called the Young Artists Series), held at Walter Hall (1998-2011); the Bayfield Festival of Song (2007-2012); and various concerts performed on tour in North America and Great Britain. Each file contains the records created and used in the production of the concert, including promotional materials (programs, posters, and pamphlets); correspondence with musicians, sponsors, and venues; newspaper clippings of concert reviews; contracts with performers and venues; research notes; narrative scripts for the Sunday Afternoon Concert Series; scores annotated by Stephen Ralls and Bruce Ubukata; arrangements and transpositions of songs; stage, set, and lighting designs; subscriber lists; and ticket sales records.

Arrangement: Arrangement by the Aldeburgh Connection. Files are listed by the title and location of the concert and listed in ascending chronological order. Note that some files are made up of two or more physical folders, which divide the records into smaller portions based on type (i.e., promotional material and programs, correspondence, research notes, and, music and scripts); if a file consists of two or more folders, the number of folders is noted under "Extent and medium." File titles were transcribed directly from the folders, as labelled by the Aldeburgh Connection, which correspond to the titles and locations of the concerts. Concerts performed as part of the Bayfield Festival of Song (2007-2012) are grouped together as one file, following the file-naming convention of the Aldeburgh Connection.

Some concerts were performed more than once, so some materials created or used in the production of a concert may be stored in another file; in these cases, the concerts are cross-referenced in a "Related units of description" note. Also see the Aldeburgh Connection's online archive (http://aldeburghconnection.org/archives); each file is linked to the relevant page in their online archive, which includes a description of the concert; a list of the titles, composers, poets, and performers for each piece included in the program; a digitized program; and, for 79 concerts from the Sunday Afternoon Concert Series, a recording of the concert. Many of recordings for the Discovery, or Young Artists, Series recitals are included in the Music Library Collection of Faculty Events (CA OTUFM Faculty Events); relevant items in this collection are linked at the file-level.
