Material includes correspondence and research materials relating to RP's research on the etchings of Wenceslaus Hollar and drafts of his book, *A Descriptive Catalogue of the Etched Work of Wencelaus Hollar*, 1607-1677 (Cambridge University Press, 1982). There is also considerable correspondence with Sidney Fisher on his collection of Hollar etchings, Shakespeare, and on other subjects.

Other material relates to RP's book: *Peterley Harvest: the Private Diary of David Peterley* (London: Hutchinson, 1960); and to his unpublished memoirs. There are also letters from various English authors and correspondence and papers relating to RP's work as librarian and secretary for the National Liberal Club, London, Eng. in the 1930s and for the Czechoslovakian Committee, which he was instrumental in founding in London in May 1938. Additional material relates to two visits to Czechoslovakia in 1938. Some later material relates to RP's private press publications.

Donated in several accessions, beginning in 1982.

**Restrictions:** Early drafts of RP's autobiography (Boxes 14-16) are restricted until after his death.

Family correspondence (Box 28) is restricted until RP's death. Other materials are available without restriction as of November 1999. (See letter from RP, dated November 1999)
