Richard Pinch Bowles was a graduate of Victoria University (B.A., Master's and Divinity degrees) who was ordained as a Methodist minister in 1888. After serving several prominent pastorates, Dr. Bowles joined the Faculty of Theology of Victoria University in 1906. He became President/Chancellor in 1913, holding this post until retiring in 1930.

Scope and content

Fonds consists of incoming and outgoing correspondence re family, friends, Victoria University, charities and social and other activities and interests, [n.d.], 1913–1929; addresses for special Victoria University occasions, and on various subjects including theology and the relationship of students to the university, [n.d.], 1919–1928; baccalaureate addresses, 1915, 1916, 1923, 1924, 1925, 1927, 1928; address by Bowles and addresses by others at his installation as President, 1913; lecture notes, [n.d.]; manuscripts of theological articles/books, 1946–1947; and a historical account of Dr. Bowles ancestors.
