

This accession contains the personal records of S. D. Clark, first chair of the Department of Sociology at the University of Toronto, and such records as Professor Clark retained that had originally belonged to Oswald Hall. Professor Hall had a varied career before joining the Department of Sociology at McGill University in 1946. He left in 1953 and came to the University of Toronto where he remained until 1969. From 1964-1966 he was Research Supervisor with the Royal Commission on Bilingualism and Biculturalism.
