Scope and Content: The collection of Polish uncensored publications and Solidarity/[Solidarność] material at the University of Toronto Library includes non-periodical publications, graphics, photographs, cassettes, medals, stamps, artifacts, posters as well as other material generated by "Solidarność" and related organizations in Poland and internationally. Periodicals, books and pamphlets which initially constituted the largest part of the collection, have been catalogued separately. Some of the collection highlights include bulletins and documents issued by the Coordinating Office Abroad of NSZZ "Solidarność" and by international groups organized in support of NSZZ "Solidarność." Canadian organizations and initiatives are represented extensively. In 1983, the call to expand the collection was issued to private donors to donate Polish Solidarity material in their possession, and the collection has grown since then.

The collection is organized according to three major criteria:

- medium of communication
- date and place of origin
- language of communication

Printed matter is organized in four master files:

- I. PRE-SOLIDARITY period: June 1976- August 31, 1980
- II. SOLIDARITY LEGAL period: September 1, 1980-December 12, 1981
- III. MARTIAL LAW period: December 13, 1981-July 22, 1983
- IV. POST-MARTIAL LAW period: July 23, 1983 to present.
- V. VISUAL ARTS

Within each of the four master files all the publications are segregated according to two categories, with further subdivision by publishing organization:

- documents, leaflets and other ephemera
- research papers

Items representing other media of communication form the fifth master file.

An item is identified by its code label which determines its place within the collection. The label consists of two numbers: Box number B and folder number F, followed by an acronym of master file; e.g. the code label B5 F27 SL means the item placed in Box 5, Folder 27 in the SOLIDARITY LEGAL period file. The following acronyms are employed:

Source of Acquisition: The collection was established in 1981 and has been continuously developed since then. The aim of the Library is to collect material related to independent social and political organizations in Poland, beginning June 1976, and thus to facilitate research into the history of Polish democratic opposition, principally of NSZZ "Solidarność" [Independent Self-governing Trade Union "Solidarity"].

In 2020, the collection incorporated donation of materials by Mark Lukasiewicz, who was a Globe and Mail reporter from 1979 to 1983. In 1982 and 1983, he travelled to Poland and wrote a series of articles covering martial law and its aftereffects. Lukasiewicz donated these materials to the Thomas Fisher Rare Book Library in April 2017. His extensive publications shed light on Canadian reception of Solidarity as well as provided a glimpse of covering of the events in Poland for Canadian contemporaries. His donation includes scrapbook-albums with photographs of the events in Poland and various ephemera, as well as newspaper publications (catalogued separately).

Language: Polish [primary language], English, French, other languages.

Terms of Access: Available for faculty, students, and researchers engaged in scholarly projects.

Location: Thomas Fisher Rare Book Library, University of Toronto (2B Annex).

Processing Information: Processed in 2020 by Natalia Barykina. The current finding aid is an updated version of *Finding Aids for the Solidarity Collection in the Thomas Fisher Rare Book Library*, University of Toronto, by Bogumila Pawlik-Peczki (1988).

I. PRE-SOLIDARITY MASTER FILE

The PRE-SOLIDARITY period file is comprised of the earliest publications of the Polish democratic opposition, together with research papers and newspaper clippings, covering the period from June 25th, 1976 to August 31st, 1980, i.e. from the strikes in Radom and Ursus and the subsequent founding of KOR (the Committee for Defense of the Workers) to the strike at the Lenin Shipyard in the Gdańsk Accords and founding of NSZZ "Solidarność."

The file is divided into two parts. The first part contains publications which originated in Poland, English or French translations of the most important documents issued by the opposition organizations, as well as statements of Polish government in exile and Polish Canadian press clippings.

The second part contains research papers and newspaper clippings which originated in other countries. Situation reports and western reviews of Polish uncensored publications are included. Both parts are arranged chronologically, with further subdivision in respect to particular organizations.

III. THE MARTIAL LAW PERIOD MASTER FILE

The Martial Law period commenced on December 13th, 1981 with the imposition of Martial Law in Poland, and ended on July 22nd, 1983 when it was cancelled by the Polish authorities.

The MARTIAL LAW period file consists of two parts: the material assumed to be published in Poland during Martial Law and the material published within this period in countries other than Poland. Both parts are arranged in geographical order; newspaper clippings are arranged chronologically.

IV. THE POST-MARTIAL LAW PERIOD MASTER FILE

The POST-MARTIAL LAW period file comprises publications generated after July 22nd, 1983, the day of the official cancellation of Martial Law in Poland.

The arrangement of the file is similar to that of the Martial Law period file: the material published in Poland is separated from the material published outside of Poland and is arranged geographically, with further subdivision by publishing organization. All publications are segregated according to two categories: documents, leaflets and other ephemera; research papers. Documents, leaflets and other ephemera are arranged by country of origin and issuing organization, excluding newspaper clippings. The latter are of three types: the Polish official (censored) press clippings, the Polish Canadian press clippings and the press clippings in languages other than Polish. Clippings in Polish are filed according to their country of origin-Poland or Canada.

Research papers are arranged in alphabetical order by author or title.

This file also includes periodicals that were published outside of Poland. They are arranged by the country of origin.

V. THE VISUAL ARTS MASTER FILE

Items in THE VISUAL ARTS Master file represent other media of communication (microfilm and various visual arts materials). THE VISUAL ARTS Master file consists of 8 boxes. It includes materials donated by Mark Lukaszewicz, a *Globe and Mail* reporter from 1979 to 1983. Donated in 2017, these materials include scrapbook-albums with photographs of the events in Poland and various ephemera, as well as newspaper publications. Newspaper publications were catalogued separately.

Oversized posters are shelved separately. In the 1988 finding aid, these posters are described at the item level and include the name of the artist, size, colour, etc. Since then, more posters were added, and the collection has grown. It includes posters of "Solidarność and related organizations, including a number of posters for 1989 election campaign, as well as Polish United Workers' Party posters, junta's posters and Gazeta plakatowa posters (published by Wydawnictwo Wydziału Informacji KC PZPR). The poster collection also includes the works of Andrzej Radwański, Pamięć polskich pól, Cracow 1985 and posters published outside of Poland.
