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## Biographical note

William Beverley Scott, known to family, friends and colleagues as "Bev", was born on 7 July 1917 in Toronto, Ontario, the only child of William James Scott and Elsie Irene Lowry. As a child, he spent a lot of time along the shore of Lake Ontario near his home and in non-urban patches he could reach by bicycle. During the annual family camping vacation on Lake Nipissing, his father took him fishing, introducing him to the varieties of fish in the lake. As a teenager, he set up a number of fish tanks in his basement and soon started selling the fish he did not need.

Bev was first introduced to the rigors of scientific methodology through a summer job at the Toronto Public Health Laboratory. He took zoology in high school, where his teacher suggested he visit the aquarium at the Royal Ontario Museum. Not impressed with what he found, he went to see the director of the ROM, J. R. Dymond, who suggested he volunteer.

1938 was a pivotal year for Bev. He met his future wife, Mildred (Milly) Fairfield during summer vacation and in the fall he enrolled at the University of Toronto where his interest, under Dymond's influence, focused on zoology and fishes. In the fall of 1939 his mother died and, with the outbreak of World War II, he joined the University of Toronto contingent of the Canadian Officer Training Corps. On graduation in 1942, he got married and went into active service with the Royal Canadian Corps of Signals. He trained as a meteorologist, went overseas that fall and landed in France on his birthday in 1944. Recovering in England from a wound suffered during a misplaced bomb drop, he visited the British Museum at the request of Professor Dymond, who encouraged him to consider graduate studies on his return to Canada. During the summers from 1946 to 1949 he conducted field work in Lake Erie for his doctoral thesis and served as acting curator of fishes at the Royal Ontario Museum.

Upon completing his PhD, *Lake Erie cisco (Leucichthys artedi)* population, in 1950, Bev was hired as Curator of Fishes at the ROM, the first to hold that position there. He was also appointed a lecturer in the Department of Zoology at the University of Toronto, rising to the position of Professor in 1968. At the ROM, his research focused on Canadian freshwater fishes. While much effort went to filling the gaps in the collections from eastern Canada, he also sought to expand the holdings of western fishes, which he did in conjunction with Edwin J. Crossman who arrived at the U of T in 1952. They worked closely together and co-published the classic *The Freshwater Fishes of Canada* in 1973 under the auspices of the Fisheries Research Board of Canada. A revised edition was never published because of Crossman's death in 2003.

After 1962, following an introduction to the biological station at St. Andrew's, New Brunswick, Professor Scott's fieldwork shifted largely to the Atlantic fishes and his research and publications turned to an increasingly comprehensive series of papers on the Canadian Atlantic ichthyofaunal, including *Fishes of the Atlantic Coast of Canada* (1966), a manuscript he completed following the death of its author, A. H. Leim. His publication total, including articles, book chapters, and books, was about 110 titles. This does not include the many unpublished reports and monographs that he penned for his workplaces and other organizations.

Professor Scott retired from the ROM in 1976 and was appointed professor emeritus of the University of Toronto in 1983. He and Milly moved to St. Andrew's, where he was offered the position of Director of the Huntsman Marine Science Centre, a position he held until 1982, when he was appointed a Senior Scientist. There he and Milly completed a revised and expanded edition (1988) of his book with Leim; it appeared as the *Atlantic Fishes of Canada*. He also established a larval sorting centre at St. Andrew's.

Professor Scott's priorities always included conservation, education, and public service. His *Freshwater fishes of Eastern Canada* (1954), for example, was written for the layman, not academia. The organizations he joined or was appointed to ranged across his interests with focuses from local to international activities. These included the Bellairs Research Institute of McGill University, Toronto Anglers and Hunters Association, the Metropolitan Toronto Zoological Society (it was involved in planning the Metropolitan Toronto Zoo), the Sunbury Shores Arts and Nature Centre, the Canadian Wildlife Association, the Canadian Council for Freshwater Fisheries Research, the American Fisheries Society, and the American Society of Ichthyologists and Herpetologists (Board of Governors, 1962; president, 1973).

Professor Scott's contribution to his field was recognized in the number of honours he received: the Canada Centennial Medal (1967), Canadian Silver Jubilee Medal (1977), the American Fisheries Society Award for Excellence (1985), honorary degrees (University of New Brunswick, 1985; Queen's University, 1994), fellow of the Royal Society of Canada (1983), and Honorary Member of the Canadian Society of Zoology (1993). Professor Scott is featured in two videos, *Scott and Crossman: the freshwater fisheries of Canada* (on science.gc.ca website), and on a video prepared by Vanessa Minke -Martin (*History within history*). His extensive personal library was donated to Queen's University.

In 1998, with Milly's health failing, the Scotts left St. Andrews for Kingston, Ontario where the health facilities were better. They had honeymooned there and Bev had taken his military training there before going overseas during World War II. They were given a

grand sendoff at the Algonquin Hotel in St. Andrews on June 27<sup>th</sup>. Milly died in 2006 and Bev on 18 August 2014. They are survived by two children, Paul James Scott and Patricia Louise Scott.

Personal records of W. Beverley Scott, Professor Emeritus of Zoology at the University of Toronto, former Curator of Fishes at the Royal Ontario Museum, and former Director of the Huntsman Marine Science Centre in St. Andrews, New Brunswick. The records include correspondence, certificates, diaries, travel files, journals and field notes, research files, manuscripts and publications, and drafts of addresses, with associated photographs, slides, x-rays, notes, other related material, and a number of packets of fish scales.

This accession contains approximately 400 photoprints and 200 negatives and strip negatives, along with 41 slides, 48 x-rays, a few postcards, and a number of drawings.

His papers include mainly correspondence, research notes including data logs on the "Splake", manuscripts and files from the Great Lakes Fisheries Commission.

Records assembled by Frederick E. J. Fry relating to fisheries research projects of the Departments of Biology and Zoology and the Ontario Fisheries Research Board, with additional correspondence by Henry A. Regier of the Institute for Environmental Studies. Researchers include J. R. Dymond: speckled trout study for Sir William Mulock, 1926; William J. K. Harkness: Ontario legislature's Game Fish Committee, 1928-1929; Biological Board of Canada's Research Committee of Fish Culture, 1930-1931; Essex Border Utilities Commission, 1931-1932; Dunlap Atlantic salmon experiments, 1936-1940, and other fish management issues, 1930-1945; J. Murray Spiers: Great Lakes fisheries research, 1949-1950; V. R. Chapman and F. E. J. Fry: Ontario Fisheries Research Board, 1947-1953; and K. R. S. Fisher: flora studies, Fort Churchill, 1951.

**Huntsman, Archibald Gowanlock**, B1974-0021. Sound recordings: 2 sound tape reels (130 mins.), 3 May 1973

Oral History interview by Elizabeth Wilson. Covers arrival at University of Toronto through post-retirement work, ca. 1902-73. Focusses on his research on fish reproduction and migration, on fishery products, and on fish preservation for the Fisheries Research Board of Canada. Discusses University Presidents Falconer, Cody, Smith and Bissell, and Faculty members in the Faculty of Medicine and the Dept. of Biology.

**Huntsman, Archibald Gowanlock**, B1978-0010. Textual, graphic, publications, artifacts, 1919-1965, 22.16 m.

Correspondence, research notes, manuscripts, ca. 1600 sample fish scales, maps, articles, offprints, newspaper clippings dealing with Huntsman's research, initially with freshwater fish but primarily with Atlantic salmon. Also includes publications, photoprints, photographic negatives, aerial photographs, scrapbooks and some slides.

**Huntsman, Archibald Gowanlock**, B1979-0048. Textual, 1.95 m.

Reports, addresses and manuscripts relating to research on fisheries, and the Biological Board of Canada. Also includes correspondence, offprints, clippings and notes.

**Huntsman, Archibald Gowanlock**, B1988-0015. Textual, graphic, 1915-1953, 0.34 m.

Correspondence, minutes, notes, manuscripts and reports on the study of (primarily salmon) fishery management and migration. Also includes files on the Biological Board of Canada, and the Ontario Fisheries Research Committee. Photographs, in chronological order, document fishing locations at the Margaree and Moses Rivers and other lakes and falls in the Maritimes, and deal with migration of fish, traps, construction of Round Lake fishing dam, and other related topics.

**Huntsman, Archibald Gowanlock**, B2005-0006. Textual, graphic, artifacts, 1896-1978, 4.27 m.

Personal records of Archibald Gowanlock Huntsman, documenting his life career as a professor of Marine Biology at the University of Toronto and an expert on the behavior of Atlantic salmon (*Salmo salar*). Includes diaries, correspondence, research files (including fish scales), memoranda, minutes, notes, photographs, reports, drafts of publications and addresses. The correspondence centres on the Biological (later Fisheries) Research Board of Canada, Huntsman's colleagues at the U of T (especially Thomas Goudge) and elsewhere. Also, files on

conferences, organizations such as the Ontario advisory committees on Lake Erie and Lake Huron fisheries, Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution, Royal Society of Canada, and the Royal Lunch Club at the U of T. Huntsman's writings are primarily from his post-retirement years and centre on issues relating to fisheries research, especially the movement of salmon, but also critiques of evolution.

## **Series 1: Personal and biographical**

**Date range:** 1936-2013

**Extent:** 0.43 m (7 boxes) of textual, graphic material

**Scope and content:** This series includes curriculum vitae and other personal information, files on Professor Scott's education, his military service during World War II, appointments and honours bestowed on him, and some of his other personal and family activities. Included are files on two film projects and an interview.

Professor Scott and his wife, Milly, travelled extensively once he took early retirement from the Royal Ontario Museum; many of their trips from 1976 to 2013 are documented here. Some travel accounts can also be found in Series 3: Diaries/Field record books. Photographs relating to their travels have, for the most part, been removed to Series 9: Photographs.

**Extent:** 0.34 m (4 boxes) of textual records

**Scope and content:** This series is comprised of files of letters that Professor Scott denoted as "correspondence", primarily with colleagues and other professionals, but including some personal correspondence. Related correspondence may also be found in other series, especially Series IV: employment. Included are letters of reference (some are found in other series, interspersed with a variety of material), and letters of appraisal for manuscripts sent to him and of theses he supervised.

**Date range:** 1938-2013

**Extent:** 1.68 m (19 boxes) of textual records

**Scope and content:** This series contains the surviving diaries written by Professor Scott over his professional career and his post-retirement years (1939-2013), some of which have few entries. There are also a number of daybooks and field records books, 1938-1954, with scattered ones after that, including some taken while on research cruises. Many are accompanied by loose notes, charts, tables, daily catch record cards, maps, sketches, press clippings, correspondence, and other items. Related material includes, in particular, the numerous research files in Series 6: Research and professional work, which contains some more field books.

### **Series 4: Employment**

**Date range:** 1922-2013

**Extent:** 0.78 m (9 boxes) of textual, publications and graphic material

**Scope and content:** This series covers Professor Scott's employment with the University of Toronto/Royal Ontario Museum as the first head of the Department of Ichthyology and Herpetology, and, later as Director of the Huntsman Marine Laboratory (later the Huntsman Marine Science Centre) in St. Andrews, New Brunswick. Files on two University of Toronto professors, Alexander Henry Leim and Archibald Gowanlock Huntsman, who spent a great deal of time at the Biological Station in St. Andrews during its early years are included in this series.

The files contain correspondence, minutes of meetings, lecture notes, notes, inventories, material relating to the history of the ROM and its Department of Ichthyology and Herpetology, (including information leaflets written by Professor Scott), newsletters, photographs, press clippings and reports. Additional photographs are located in Series 9: Photographs.

**Scope and content:** Professor Scott was a member of fifteen organizations and societies and worked with others on contract. This series documents some of his activities but the files are not comprehensive or complete for most of them. Additional documentation may be found in other series, especially Series 2: Correspondence and Series 4: Employment.

The files contain correspondence, memoranda, minutes of meeting, articles, newsletters, reports, press clippings and conference material.

## **Series 6: Research and professional work**

**Date range:** 1903-2015

**Extent:** 2.0 m (boxes) of textual, publications and graphic material

**Scope and content:** The files in this series were assembled by Professor Scott during his long career as a researcher, writer, and an expert on fisheries in Canada, initially freshwater files and latterly saltwater varieties. They contain a wide variety of material, ranging from correspondence, postcards, notes, charts, data sheets, sketches, maps, (a few) log books, reports, theses, notes and reports on research and fishes written by Professor Scott, newsletters photographs, slides, and x-rays These files relate to research done in the field, for reports, articles, and chapters of books. Also included are booklets, newsletters, and press clippings, and scholarly articles and reports written by others that were either collected by or sent to him. Included is some material acquired or written by Professor Scott's older colleagues such as J. R. Dymond. Some of the notes, taken by

them are undated but reach back to the 1920s. There is also some correspondence dating back even further.

## **Series 7: Manuscripts and publications**

**Date range:** 1902-2013

**Extent:** 0.98 m (8 boxes) of textual, graphic and publications

**Scope and content:** During his lifetime Professor Scott penned some 110 books, chapters of books, and articles; also a number of book reports. This series contains some of them and a few unpublished manuscripts. There are substantial files on three of his books, *Fishes of the Atlantic Coast of Canada* (1966), *The Freshwater Fishes of Canada* (1973) and the *Atlantic Fishes of Canada* (1988). Professor Scott also wrote a number of information leaflets for the Royal Ontario Museum and hundreds of research reports (large and small). Some of the latter can be found in Series 6: Research and professional work and very occasionally in Series 3: Diaries/field record books. The material in this series includes drafts of manuscripts, correspondence, notes, research data, maps, sketches, photonegatives and photoprints.

### **Series 10: Photographs**

**Date range:** 1920-2005

**Extent:** 0.40 m (boxes) of graphic material

**Scope and content:** The photoprints, photonegatives, slides and x-rays in this series document some of Professor Scott's personal activities, beginning with trips he made, starting in 1957 when he undertook a research trip to Trinidad. This file is followed by a selection of images from holiday trips (combined with professional interest) from 1984 to 1997. The photoprints for the Scott's Asia trip in 1997, which are annotated, have been mostly retained. Files relating to these trips are located in Series 1: Personal and biographical and Series 3: Diaries/field record books.

The trip photographs are followed by images of Professor Scott, some relating to his military service, and some of his family. Next are images relating to his professional activities at the Royal Ontario Museum and at the Huntsman Marine Laboratory, which

are arranged chronologically. Approximately half of the images are of fish that were used in his research and in his publications.

**Note:** Professor Scott identified many of the individuals shown in the photoprints and dated many of the photographs.
