### **Biographical Note:**

Eldon Garnet, born in 1946, is a photographer, sculptor and writer based in Toronto. He is best known for his large-scale photographs, which exhibit extensively, and his public sculptures in Toronto. He is an author, and for 15 years he was editor and publisher of Impulse Magazine, an award-winning magazine of architecture, design, art, culture, and literature that reached its peak in the late 1980s.
